<p><b>Import call recordings from non-ipSCAPE systems</b></p> <p>In Vault 1.1, we have introduced the functionality to import and store call recordings from third party applications via streams.</p> <p>Vault 1.1 also provides access to non-ipSCAPE workspace users, as it can now be used as a stand-alone product.</p> <p>Import of .mp3 &amp; .wav files from non-ipSCAPE systems are supported.</p> <p>Please reach out to your Account Manager for further information about this product.</p>	Records
<p>A new top-level menu has been introduced to the left-hand side UI panel, to house the modules under the headings <i>Records</i> &amp; <i>Settings</i>.</p> <p>The <i>Logs</i> are now available under <i>Settings</i>.</p> <p>Four new modules have been introduced under <i>Settings</i> – Users, Roles, Streams, Schemas and Attributes pool.</p>	UI

<p>the default '<i>ipSCAPE Default Stream</i>' tab on the homepage. The default stream cannot be deleted.</p>	
<p><b>Streams Module</b></p> <p>Users can now create new streams to upload call recordings to Vault using the newly added <i>Streams</i> module under <i>Settings</i>. The created streams will appear as separate tabs on the Vault homepage.</p>	Streams
<p><b>Schemas Module</b></p> <p>Users will now be able to create Schemas to enable import of data streams and map their metadata.</p> <p>Users can create schemas from the newly added <i>Schemas</i> module under <i>Settings</i>. Users can assign the schema to the streams.</p>	Schemas
<p><b>Attributes Pool Module</b></p> <p>Users can create attributes from the newly added <i>Attributes Pool</i> module under <i>Settings</i>. These attributes can then be assigned to schemas.</p> <p>The following data types are supported for attributes: Date and time, Date, Time, Number, Text, Dropdown, Phone, Email, List, Object.</p> <p>Users can delete attributes, only if it is not assigned to a schema.</p> <p>User can modify the name of an attribute.</p>	Attributes Pool

<p><b>Users Module</b></p> <p>Customers can now create, edit, and delete Vault users thereby enabling platform access management.</p> <p>Login details can also be set for the user and users can be activated or deactivated by enabling/disabling their login.</p> <p>Users can assign a role or delete another user's login based on their set permission levels.</p>	Users
<p><b>Roles Module</b></p> <p>Customers can now create and set permissions for the roles and assign roles to the users.</p> <p>Based on the set permission levels, users can assign/ unassign and delete roles from other users.</p>	Roles
